NOTES: This is a free web-based learning environment for kids ages 8 to 12. It is considered a “Safe Zone” which means enrollment requires parent consent, identity information is not shared with others, and there are no external links within CyberCamp. As virtual campers, kids learn about their world through activities that promote understanding of ecosystems, discovery of art and culture, and learning about health and safety.

Take the virtual tour to learn how to navigate with the “Camper Digital Assistant” and use the map to find the activities. Environments include the freshwater lake, campfire, and meadow. Topics include habitats, physical science, and recycling. Kids can even listen to songs and write their own to submit!
